How to Enable the Founder's Vision of a Free Republic

WE THE PEOPLE: The engaged grassroots citizen is essential to restoring liberty in America. They are the real heroes, and they must act at the local-state-national level to ensure American citizens can remain free into the future.

This list provides options for citizens to act upon.

1. Visit us at www.restore-liberty.org to sign the Declaration of Constitutional Consent. First digitally, then download it-print-sign-mail it to the White House and your Governor at a minimum. This sends a message that We the People demand adherence to Constitutional principles.
2. Set your personal expectations as a person and a community for what it means to defend the Constitution against over-reach.

LOCAL

- Run for city and county commission/council offices.
- Serve on local advisory boards, like a citizens' council.
- Run for school boards, even if you don't have children in the school system.
- Testify to commissions/councils and hold them accountable to their votes.
- Eliminate Critical Race Theory (CRT) in all forms and at all levels, to ensure we remain United not divided.
- Establish local civic groups not formally tied to any political entity to discuss critical concerns in your local area.
- If school boards will not listen to the concerns of parents, then groups of parents should pool their resources, hire their own teacher, and remove their children from government schools thereby gaining a better and more effective educational experience.
- Do not allow unelected staff employees to make decisions best made by elected officials who can then be held accountable for those decisions. (Example: health board)
- Divest funds from any business or institution that erodes liberty and free speech, exacerbates divisions along any line, and embraces Marxist ideals in any form.
- Visit the Patriot Academy or Hillsdale College and begin to use good curriculum like these to host classes for all ages on the Constitution and Civics. (These are two examples, there are likely others.)
- Consistently speak up against those who would seek to use violence for political gain.
- Require the pledge of allegiance at all meetings.
- Support all Constitutionally minded student groups, and demand school boards allow for equal treatment for the same.
- Host a voter registration drive.
- Serve as a poll watcher, workers and/or election judge.
- Volunteer to monitor vote counting/recounts.

- Write a letter to editor.
- Hand-write messages and thank you-s to volunteers, activists, politicians, and other leaders.
- Monitor social media for "opposition" activity.
- Coordinate transportation for people to get to polls (ie elderly).
- Fight for election/voter integrity.
- Consistently speak up against those who would seek to use LIES for political gain.
- Consistently speak up against those who would seek to use RACISM for political gain.
- Learn how to serve as a campaign manager, consultant, or treasurer to allow candidates to focus on the message they to share.

STATE

- Contest every state house and senate race.
- Serve on state advisory boards.
- Show up to provide testimony for or against bills, use the Constitution to determine where you stand.
- Remain consistently engaged with your state legislators. This includes encouraging those who uphold Constitutional principles and holding accountable those who do not.
- Demand legislators explore how to minimize the affect of the strings attached to federal dollars. If necessary, turn back federal aid in order to retain all decision making at the local level.

NATIONAL

- Constantly write your congressional representative and your state senators regardless of their party. Let your voice be heard as often as possible.
- Engage with companies that pursue division over unity. (Facebook, Twitter, Google, MLB, NBA, NFL, etc.)
- Find all alternative sources of media that adhere to truth and constitutional principles, then support them.

CONSIDER A "NO RALLY" POLICY: Rallies to support events or actions are occasionally of value but consider the fact that these rallies take time and resources that could be better used to engage in the direct political process. Writing letters, making phone calls, building teams, supporting candidates, or any recommended task on the list we are providing you.

BUILD A TEAM: Many local races are considered non-partisan but still need support to accomplish everything necessary to a winning campaign. Build teams to support candidates at every level, partisan, or non-partisan. Learn the political process and rally around the candidates that adhere to traditional American values and the Constitution. This includes treasurers, campaign managers, election judges, poll watchers, door knockers, social media specialists, etc. This team can also track legislation and voting records.

MEDIA: If your local media is not accountable to the people, seek funding to start your own media and get the truth out. Meanwhile, engage with your local paper and radio stations and work to make sure they understand the citizens want honest journalism and not an agenda.
