AFFIDAVIT OF FACT

Dear **Supervisor**,

I, **First Name Last Name**, a man, have personal knowledge of, and asseverate the following:

1. I received an e-mail on mandatory vaccines, **Exhibit C**, which states the following:
 - "...only FDA approved vaccines will be utilized for mandatory vaccinations..."
 - "...the currently approved vaccine for mandatory issue is a two-dose series (COMIRNATY® or Pfizer BioNTech), to meet the 2 Nov deadline..."
 - "...We will be administering the Pfizer BioNTech vaccine at WPAFB."
2. I claim that the guidance from the Secretary of Defense requires that, "Mandatory vaccination against COVID-19 will only use COVID-19 vaccines that receive full licensure from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), in accordance with FDA-approved labeling and guidance." See Exhibit A.
3. I claim that Pfizer BioNTech labeled vaccines are NOT an FDA approved product and have not received full licensure from the FDA.
4. I claim that administration of Pfizer BioNTech labeled vaccines are not compliant with FDA-Approved labeling for vaccines that receive full licensure and are not compliant with Secretary of Defense Guidance on using only vaccines compliance with FDA-approved labeling, Exhibit A.
5. I claim that Comirnaty and Pfizer BioNTech are legally distinct, and cannot be used interchangeably with respect to legality, see Note [1], Exhibit B, which states that "The products are legally distinct".
6. I claim that Comirnaty and Pfizer BioNTech can only be used interchangeably with respect to safety and effectiveness, see Exhibit B.
7. I claim that vaccine bottles labeled Pfizer BioNTech have the legal distinction as being under Emergency Use Authorization, see Exhibit B.

8. I claim that only vaccines with the label of Comirnaty have been approved by the FDA as of the date **today's date**, and that vaccines with the label of Pfizer BioNTech are legally distinct, requiring administration under the laws governing Emergency Use Authorization, and therefore require fully informed consent [option to refuse] prior to administration in accordance with the Conditions for authorization of unapproved products in U.S.C Title 21, Chapter 9, Sub Chapter V, Part E, Section 360bbb-3(e)(1)(A).

9. I claim that administering Pfizer BioNTech vaccines as if they were FDA approved or as if they were a licensed vaccine, is fraud.

- Fraud: False representation of a matter of fact, by false or misleading allegations, or by concealment of what should have been disclosed

10. I claim that any order to administer Pfizer-BioNTech labeled vaccines as if they were legal equivalents to the FDA approved Comirnaty or as if they were a licensed vaccine, is an unlawful order.

11. I require evidence proving that the statement, "providers can use doses distributed under the EUA to administer the vaccination series as if the doses were the licensed vaccine," is NOT in violation of FDA guidance.

12. I claim that in accordance with the Nuremberg Code Principles, The voluntary consent of the human subject is absolutely essential for any drug administered under the legal status of experimental use authorization. This means that the person involved should have legal capacity to give consent; should be situated as to be able to exercise free power of choice, without the intervention of any element of force, fraud, deceit, duress, over-reaching, or other ulterior form of constraint or coercion, and should have sufficient knowledge and comprehension of the elements of the subject matter involved as to enable him to make an understanding and enlightened decision.

13. I claim that any administration of Pfizer BioNTech labeled vaccine bottles requires transparent disclosure as to its legal status and lawful requirements for consent [option to refuse], and that any elements of force, fraud, deceit, duress, over-reaching, or other ulterior forms of constraint or coercion, such as mandates, orders, threats, and deceitful equivocations implying that Pfizer BioNTech labeled vaccines can be administered as if they were FDA approved or licensed vaccines are not consistent with the military oath of office or our core values of integrity first, service before self, and excellence in all we do.

14. I, a man, retain the right to decline all attempts to access, influence and or otherwise alter any and all of my God-given biological material and or biological systems which are unique, flawless and original design and craftsmanship of my Creator and of which my Creator has granted me sole possession, proprietorship and use of.

I am not an expert in the law, however I do know right from wrong. If there is any man or woman damaged by any statements herein, if they will inform me by facts, I will sincerely make every effort to amend my ways. I hereby and herein reserve the right to amend and make amendment to this document as necessary in order that the truth may be ascertained and proceedings justly determined.

If the parties given notice by means of this document have information that would controvert and overcome this Affidavit of Fact, please advise me "In written affidavit form" within ten [10] days from receipt. Provide me with your counter-affidavit, proving with particularity by stating all requisite actual evidentiary fact and all requisite actual law, and not merely the ultimate facts or conclusions of law, proving that this Affidavit of Fact is substantially and materially false sufficiently, to change materially my Status and factual declarations. Your silence stands as consent to, and tacit agreement of, the Claim and factual declarations made herein being established as matters of fact and matters of law. May the will of our Heavenly Father, through the power and authority of the blood of his son be done on Earth as it is in Heaven.

MEMORANDUM FOR SENIOR PENTAGON LEADERSHIP
COMMANDERS OF THE COMBATANT COMMANDS
DEFENSE AGENCY AND DOD FIELD ACTIVITY DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: Mandatory Coronavirus Disease 2019 Vaccination of Department of Defense Service Members

To defend this Nation, we need a healthy and ready force. After careful consultation with medical experts and military leadership, and with the support of the President, I have determined that mandatory vaccination against coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is necessary to protect the Force and defend the American people.

Mandatory vaccinations are familiar to all of our Service members, and mission-critical inoculation is almost as old as the U.S. military itself. Our administration of safe, effective COVID-19 vaccines has produced admirable results to date, and I know the Department of Defense will come together to finish the job, with urgency, professionalism, and compassion.

I therefore direct the Secretaries of the Military Departments to immediately begin full vaccination of all members of the Armed Forces under DoD authority on active duty or in the Ready Reserve, including the National Guard, who are not fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

Service members are considered fully vaccinated two weeks after completing the second dose of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine or two weeks after receiving a single dose of a one-dose vaccine. Those with previous COVID-19 infection are not considered fully vaccinated.

Mandatory vaccination against COVID-19 will only use COVID-19 vaccines that receive full licensure from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), in accordance with FDA-approved labeling and guidance. Service members voluntarily immunized with a COVID-19 vaccine under FDA Emergency Use Authorization or World Health Organization Emergency Use Listing in accordance with applicable dose requirements prior to, or after, the establishment of this policy are considered fully vaccinated. Service members who are actively participating in COVID-19 clinical trials are exempted from mandatory vaccination against COVID-19 until the trial is complete in order to avoid invalidating such clinical trial results.

Mandatory vaccination requirements will be implemented consistent with DoD Instruction 6205.02, "DoD Immunization Program," July 23, 2019. The Military Departments should use existing policies and procedures to manage mandatory vaccination of Service members to the extent practicable. Mandatory vaccination of Service members will be subject to any identified contraindications and any administrative or other exemptions established in Military Department policy. The Military Departments may promulgate appropriate guidance to carry out the requirements set out above. The Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and



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Readiness may provide additional guidance to implement and comply with FDA requirements or Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations.

The Secretaries of the Military Departments should impose ambitious timelines for implementation. Military Departments will report regularly on vaccination completion using established systems for other mandatory vaccine reporting.

Our vaccination of the Force will save lives. Thank you for your focus on this critical mission.



FACT SHEET FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS ADMINISTERING VACCINE (VACCINATION PROVIDERS)

EMERGENCY USE AUTHORIZATION (EUA) OF THE PFIZER-BIONTECH COVID-19 VACCINE TO PREVENT CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has issued an Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) to permit the emergency use of the unapproved product, Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine, for active immunization to prevent COVID-19 in individuals 12 years of age and older and to provide a third dose to individuals 12 years of age and older who have been determined to have certain kinds of immunocompromise.

COMIRNATY (COVID-19 Vaccine, mRNA) is an FDA-approved COVID-19 vaccine made by Pfizer for BioNTech. It is approved as a 2-dose series for the prevention of COVID-19 in individuals 16 years of age and older and is also authorized for emergency use in individuals 12 through 15 years and to provide a third dose to individuals 12 years of age and older who have been determined to have certain kinds of immunocompromise.

The FDA-approved COMIRNATY (COVID-19 Vaccine, mRNA) and the EUA-authorized Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine have the same formulation and can be used interchangeably to provide the COVID-19 vaccination series.¹

SUMMARY OF INSTRUCTIONS FOR COVID-19 VACCINATION PROVIDERS

Vaccination providers enrolled in the federal COVID-19 Vaccination Program must report all vaccine administration errors, all serious adverse events, cases of Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome (MIS) in adults and children, and cases of COVID-19 that result in hospitalization or death following administration of Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine. See "MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR PFIZER-BIONTECH COVID-19 VACCINE ADMINISTRATION UNDER EMERGENCY USE AUTHORIZATION" for reporting requirements.

The Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine is a suspension for intramuscular injection administered as a series of two doses (0.3 mL each) 3 weeks apart.

A third dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine (0.3 mL) administered at least 28 days following the second dose of this vaccine is authorized for administration to individuals at least 12 years of age who have undergone solid

¹ The licensed vaccine has the same formulation as the EUA-authorized vaccine and the products can be used interchangeably to provide the vaccination series without presenting any safety or effectiveness concerns. The products are legally distinct with certain differences that do not impact safety or effectiveness.

Teammates,

On Friday, SECAF signed the attached COVID Vaccination Memo directing all Active Duty uniformed Airmen and Guardians to be fully vaccinated NLT 2 Nov 21. Vaccination of Airmen and Guardians enhances force health protection and readiness. An individual is considered fully vaccinated two weeks after the second dose in a two-dose series or two weeks after receiving a single dose of a one-dose vaccine. Given the currently approved vaccine for mandatory issue is a two-dose series (COMIRNATY® or Pfizer BioNTech), to meet the 2 Nov deadline the first dose of the two-dose series must be administered NLT 28 Sep and the second dose must be administered NLT 19 Oct. A three week separation is required between dose 1 and dose 2.

The memo states only FDA approved vaccines will be utilized for mandatory vaccinations. The FDA approved the Pfizer vaccine under the name "COMIRNATY®". DAF implementation guidance states both the COMIRNATY® and Pfizer BioNTech vaccines fulfill this requirement. Per the FDA, both have the same formulation and can be used interchangeably; see attached Fact Sheet. We will be administering the Pfizer BioNTech vaccine at WPAFB.

Last Wednesday I announced we will begin the mandatory vaccination process this week. Since the AF guidance was not released until late Friday, we are sliding the mandatory vaccination pods by one week. This will give leaders time to digest the DAF Implementation Guidance, issue vaccination orders, and answer questions. Note, service members should receive their vaccination orders from their respective chain of command; the 88th Air Base Wing serves as the host unit responsible for administering the vaccine. As we roll into mandatory vaccinations for military personnel, we have no concerns with on-hand supply. Expect the mandatory pods to start the week of 13 Sep in the Medical Center Auditorium. The plan is to rotate personnel through the pod by unit. If you are an unvaccinated military member, your unit will advise you of the date and time to report for your first dose unless you choose to get it earlier.

With that said, we've seen an increase in demand recently, especially from the AD population, no doubt, trying to get ahead of the mandate and/or teammates simply recognizing the value of the FDA approved vaccine in this new wave. If you received your COVID vaccination off base and have not reported it yet, you should provide a copy of your vaccination card to the Allergy & Immunizations Clinic or upload the vaccination card's image, front and back, in a secure message to your Primary Care provider team via the Tricare Online Portal. This way we can update your records.

To set the stage for next week's mandatory vaccination pod, we are expanding COVID vaccination operations from the Allergy & Immunization Clinic to the Medical Center Auditorium. Beginning Wed, 8 Sep, Active Duty walk-in service will be available at the Auditorium. The expanded operations will

run Wed-Fri from 0800-1200. All other TRICARE eligible beneficiaries ages 12 and up, as well as Department of Defense civilians and contractors should continue to schedule an appointment by calling 937-257-SHOT (7468) or by visiting <https://informatics-stage.health.mil/WPAFBCOVIDApp/>. For the time being, these shots will continue to be administered out of the Allergy & Immunization Clinic; walk-ins are welcome, but may experience a slight wait.

In preparation for your vaccination, I encourage you to complete the attached DHA Form 207 and bring it with you to the vaccination pod. This will save you some time. Additionally, read the vaccine fact sheet attached. If you still have questions, watch the latest vaccination town hall (<https://www.dvidshub.net/video/811488/88-mdg-vaccine-town-hall>), call 257-SHOT, or send a secure message to your primary care manager.

If you are going to pursue a medical exemption or religious accommodation, let your commander or director know now. The process starts with them. Attached are a couple of Bullet Background Papers to outline the respective processes. Note, these were prepared prior to the Air Force implementation guidance released late Friday. As such, they may require minor tweaks; the team is taking a look now. Any updates will be posted to our COVID Information page (<https://www.wpafb.af.mil/coronavirus/>).

Teammates – our team is here to support you throughout this entire process, from safely administering your vaccination to navigating the medical exemption or religious accommodation processes. We also have a number of services available to help process the wide range of emotions you may be experiencing as we shift from voluntary to mandatory vaccinations. Our goal is to execute the SECDEF and SECAF's order as effective and efficiently as possible with an emphasis on you. Let me know if we are missing anything.
