

- organization whose purpose is to maintain international
  - peace and security, develop friendly relations among
  - nations, achieve international cooperation, and be a
    - centre for harmonizing the actions of nations.
  - It is the world's largest and most familiar international organization. The UN is headquartered on international territory in New York City, and has other main offices in Geneva, Nairobi, Vienna, and The Hague (home to the **International Court of Justice). (Wikipedia)**

The United States is a charter member of the United Nations and one of five permanent members of the UN Security Council. **International Organization Immunities** Act of 12-9-1945 **Congress relinquished every public office** over to the UN. Local governments up to the president and fall under UN jurisdiction. Congress gave the UN the right to dictate what laws will be international & gave them the right to tax the States.

### **International Reorganization Rescind Act**

**"To rescind and revoke membership of** the United States in the United Nations and specialized agencies thereof, and for other purposes. Be it enacted by the **Senate and House of Representatives of** the United States of America in Congress assembled.



The Unconstitutional UN Treaty

- Articles 36 and 43 of the UN Treaty are unconstitutional because they amend the I. Constitution without the consent of 3/4 of the states. There are also two laws passed pursuant to the UN Treaty which are unconstitutional for the same reason. See Reid v. Covert, 35 US1 (1957).

### **UNITED NATIONS CHARTER**



### Ratified by Assemblies of People

Approved only by Government Agents, never submitted to the American people, their legislatures or conventions to ratify. Totally iligitimate and unenforceable.

Basic rights are given by God and cannot be overruled. Freedom Prevails (Dec. of Independence 1776) Basic rights are granted by UN government and can be cancelled "by law" This world body recognizes then claims the power to abolish rights, "by law" UN's Declaration of Human Rights & Covenant on Civil & Political Rights

The right to own and bear arms is a 2nd Amendment right from the US Bill of Rights. Seeks to ban ownership of weapons- UN Arms Trade Treat would ultimately disarm Americans, signed in 2013 but never ratified by Congress

Every President swears an oath to defend and protect the US Constitution from all enemies foreign and domestic.\*



### **UNITED NATIONS STRUCTURE: SECRETARY -GENERAL**

The head of the UN is called the **Secretary-General** 

To be selected as secretarygeneral, a candidate must receive the votes of at least nine members of the United Nations Security Council, with no vetoes from permanent members. The secretary-general is then appointed by a majority vote of the United Nations General Assembly.

Equal parts diplomat and advocate, civil servant and CEO, the Secretary-General is a symbol of United Nations ideals and <u>a</u> spokesman for the interests of the world's peoples, in particular the poor and vulnerable among them. The Secretary-General is appointed by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the Security Council.

### **SPECIALIZED AGENCIES OF THE UNITED NATIONS**

<u>United Nations Specialized Agencies are autonomous organizations working</u> <u>with the United Nations</u> and each other through the coordinating machinery of the United Nations Economic and Social Council <u>at the intergovernmental level</u>, and through the Chief Executives Board for co-ordination (CEB) at the intersecretariat level.[1]

One of the principal objectives of the UN is to solve economic, social, cultural and humanitarian problems through international cooperation. <u>Several specialized</u> <u>agencies have been set up to achieve these goals, agencies which may or may</u> <u>not have been created by the United Nations</u>, but they are incorporated into the United Nations System by the United Nations Economic and Social Council acting under Articles 57 and 63 of the United Nations Charter. At present, the UN has in total 15[2][3][note 1] specialized agencies that carry out various functions on behalf of the UN.

### THE ROLE OF NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS AND THE UNITED NATIONS (AND THE WORLD)

#### NGOs are not governments and are not usually directly created by governments

The role of NGO representatives is to influence policies through participation in the entire policy-making process. What distinguishes the NGO representative's role at the U.N. from lobbying at the national level is that the representative may appeal to and discuss with the diplomats of many different governments.

Non-governmental organizations **play a vital role in the shaping and implementation of participatory democracy**. Their credibility lies in the responsible and constructive role they play in society. Formal and informal organizations, as well as grass-roots movements, **should be recognized as partners in the implementation of Agenda 21.** 

General Consultative Status (formerly Consultative Status 1), the highest level, which may be granted to organizations that are broadly representative of major segments of society in a large number of countries. Entitled to deliver oral presentations during the council's meetings.
Special Consultative Status (formerly Consultative Status 2), which may be granted to organizations concerned with only a few of the fields of activity covered by the Council
Roster, which are "other organizations that do not have general or special consultative status, considers can make occasional and useful contributions to the work of the Council."

As of August 2021, there are a total of 5,591 organizations in consultative status with ECOSOC. There are 141 organizations in general consultative status, 4,483 in special consultative status and 967 on the Roster.

**THIS May be Surprising and Troubling....** 

### **10 Planks of Communism by Karl Marx**

1. <u>Abolition of private property</u> in land and application of all rents of land to public purpose.

2. <u>A heavy progressive</u> or graduated income tax.

3. Abolition of all rights of inheritance.

4. <u>Confiscation of the property</u> of all emigrants and rebels.

5. <u>Centralization of credit</u> in the hands of the state, by means of a national bank with state capital and <u>an exclusive monopoly.</u>

6. <u>Centralization of the means of communication and transportation</u> in the hands of the state.

### **10 Planks of Communism by Karl Marx**

7. Extension of factories and instruments of production owned by the state; the bringing into cultivation of waste lands, and the improvement of the soil generally in accordance with a common plan.

8. Equal obligation of all to work and the establishment of industrial <u>armies</u>, especially for agriculture.

9. <u>Combination of agriculture with manufacturing industries; gradual</u> abolition of the distinction between town and country by a more equable distribution of the population over the country.

10. Free education for all children in government schools and abolition of children's factory labor in its present form – combination of education with industrial production, etc.
